Kits Beach Coffee Summer Makers Market is open to makers, crafters, creatives, designers, and artists who have unique small businesses, side hustles, or hobbies. We will be running Makers Markets once a month between May – September 2024.

The market is for people in Kitsilano who already have a small successful brand or a unique side hustle. This community-led market is a place to connect and network with like-minded people and new customers in your community.

Makers Market has been thoughtfully curated to create an inclusive, accessible, intimate, and inclusive experience.

Kids Mini Summer Makers Market

Mini Summer Makers Market area is for young creatives, makers, and imagineers who DREAM big.

At the Mini Summer Maker Market area, we want to create space for kids to showcase their creations and help give them a jump start on their first side hustle. We have three tables open every month for ages 5 to 16.

Examples: Arts and Crafts, Lemonade Stands, and Fundraisers.

If you are old enough to drive, you are old enough to sit with the adults at a regular table. Please apply to the regular Makers Market.

All submitted applications will be reviewed by our jury team.

Only accepted vendors will be notified by email within 72 hours.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Thank you for your interest in the Kits Beach Coffee Summer Makers Market. Each market has a maximum of 15 vendor spots available to make it an intimate, community experience.

The café will still be open to the public for takeaway to maximize walk-by exposure for our vendors.

Kits Beach Coffee Makers Market 2023 Dates:

- Sunday, August 18th, 2024

All Makers Markets take place from 10am to 4 pm at the corner of Cornwall and Walnut – 1945 Cornwall Avenue.

Applications are selected on a rolling basis in the order received. Once you submit your application you will be notified within a few days.

Vendor Fees:

Artist vendor fee registration: **\$95.00 plus tax.**

Indigenous artist vendor fee: **fee is waived.**

As a settler-owned business we recognize we are uninvited guests on these unceded ancestral lands and territories of the x^wməθk^wəyəm (Musqueam), Skwxwú7mesh (Squamish), and səlilwətał (Tsleil-Waututh) Nations.

It is with gratitude; we acknowledge our interdependence in this community known as Sənaʔq^w. We encourage, Indigenous artists, creators, and makers to register, showcase, and sell their unique crafts and wares.

What Your Vendor Fees Cover:

Your vendor fee includes a 3 x 4 rectangular table, tablecloth, chair, and wifi access.

Your investment also includes a feature post and stories at kitsbeachcoffee.com with 1-3 images, bio introduction, and your web link for the market date you register for.

As well as, being featured in our social media posts leading up to the market.

Vendor fees are due upon acceptance with full payment provided upon invoicing paid via e-transfer or credit card.

All vendor payments are non-refundable and non-transferable. Please see additional notes for details.

Vendor Cancellations:

Due to the effort involved in jurying and placement, and the costs involved in advertising and turning away other participants once the markets are full, there are, no refunds or booth credits for vendor cancellations.

Insurance:

Each vendor is responsible for their own business/personal liability insurance to cover any loss, damage, liability, or injury at the Makers Market. Participants waive all claims against Kits Beach Coffee.

Weather:

All Maker Markets will be held light rain or shine unless we call off due to severe weather or other extreme circumstances.

Kits Beach Coffee does not supply tents if it rains, therefore, ensure you have access to tents or umbrellas on rainy days. If your booth is exposed to rain, you will be required to bring your umbrella to keep your booth rain free. Cancellations by Makers Market may allow participants to roll over their booth fee to a future market date/venue of the same value.

What We Provide for Markets, and What You Need to Bring:

You Provide:

- Your Products
- A payment method (e.g. Square, Paypal, Cash, etransfer, etc)
- Displays for your products
- Shopping bags

We provide:

- 3 x 4 table
- Tablecloth
- Wifi for payment options
- Free coffee and baked good voucher
- Après Beach Voucher for a Beverage post market
- Garbage and recycling

Considerations and What Are Vendors Responsible For?

- Think of this as a producer-only market and everything that you sell must be handmade by you. Items must be original and must not use mass-produced or stock imagery.
- Any illustrations or photos used must be your own original design. This includes up-cycling of materials and fabrics.
- No reselling is allowed.
- Vendors must stay for the duration of the market.
- All back-stock must be stored under the tables or stacked neatly out of the way. They may not infringe upon the walkways or neighboring booths.
- Vendors are responsible for keeping their space looking presentable during market hours and for cleaning up their space after the market closes, including removal of all garbage and recycling and sweeping up any debris.
- NO commercial (non-vendor) advertising is allowed outside of official event sponsorships.

- Makers Market and Kits Beach Coffee are not responsible for the loss or damage of exhibitors' wares, exhibits, or personal property or for injury caused by products sold or exhibited by exhibitors. Insurance for such loss, damages, or injury shall be the responsibility of each exhibitor.
- When pricing your products please consider these guidelines carefully before applying. It has been our experience that Makers with most of their product over \$75 price point may find it hard to sell their product and end up being disappointed as a result. We recommend 50% of your items priced under \$50. And highlight your select higher priced items.
